A ***Dictionary of the Art of Printing*** is the work of William Savage (1770–1843), a British printer and engraver. Opening his own printing business in 1803 in London, he made his reputation with Edward Foster's *British Gallery of Engravings* and invented a printing ink without oil. The dictionary was compiled between 1822 and 1832, from notes gathered throughout his career. The edition on which this online version is based was published by Longman, Brown, Green and Longmans, in London, 1841.

An exceptional reference, it offers a comprehensive account of the state of the printing industry in the United Kingdom in the first part of the nineteenth century. Savage touches upon all the aspects of the trade from technical to legal, and provides a few lively peeks into bustling workshops and the habits and customs of the workers.
